

Burial Grounds Amendment.

BURIAL GROUNDS AMENDMENT ORDINANCE 1915.
1915, No. 3.

Preamble.

Whereas it is desirable to amend the Burial Grounds Ordinance 1914: Be it therefore enacted by the Synod of the Diocese of Grafton as follows:—

Amendments.

1. Clause 6 of the Burial Grounds Ordinance 1914 is hereby repealed and the following Clause inserted in lieu thereof:—
“The Table of Fees for use in all Burial Grounds vested in the Corporate Trustees shall be such as set forth in the Code of Regulations in the Schedule of this Ordinance.”

2. The Schedule to the said Ordinance shall be known as Schedule “A,” and the preamble of the Code of Regulations appearing therein is hereby repealed and the following inserted in lieu thereof:—
“The Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton in pursuance of the powers vested in them in virtue of their being charged with the care and management of the Church of England Burial Ground at (or of the Church of England portion of the General Cemetery at) do hereby make the following Regulations for the management thereof:—

3. Regulation 2 is hereby amended by the addition of the words:—
“but unless and until some other person or persons is or are appointed as such agent or agents the Vicar and Church-Wardens of the principal church of the Parish or Parochial District in which such Burial Ground is situated shall act as agents and managers.”

4. Regulation 32 is hereby repealed and the following provision inserted in lieu thereof:—
“The allotments for graves shall measure not less than three feet by eight feet (3ft. x 8ft.) nor more than twelve feet by eight feet (12ft. x 8ft.) and allotments for vaults shall measure not less than six feet by twelve feet (6ft. x 12ft.) nor more than twelve feet by twenty-four feet (12ft. x 24ft.)”

5. After Regulations 42 insert the following:—
