

Tweed Heads Land Sale Ordinance 1917.

1917 No. 1.

WHEREAS the lands more particularly described in the schedule hereto are vested in the Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton AND WHEREAS by reason of the unsuitability of the site it is expedient to sell the said land and apply the proceeds as hereinafter directed Be it therefore declared and ordained by the Synod of the Diocese of Grafton by and with the consent of the Incumbent and a majority of the Church Wardens and Parochial Council of the Parochial District of Tweed Heads and in pursuance of the powers in that behalf conferred by the Church of England Property Act 1899 as follows:—

1. The Corporate Trustees in whom the said lands are vested are hereby empowered and directed to sell the said lands either by public auction or private contract and on such terms as they shall think fit with full power to execute the necessary transfers and assurances for transferring and conveying the said lands to the purchasers thereof.

2. No purchaser of the said land under the powers hereby conferred shall be bound or concerned to enquire whether such power shall have been duly and properly exercised in accordance with the next preceding section or be affected by any notice to the contrary.

3. The moneys arising out of such sale shall be applied towards the purchase of a more suitable Church site at Tweed Heads provided that no moneys shall be so expended without the prior sanction of the Bishop-in-Council.

4. This Ordinance may be cited as the "Tweed Heads Land Sale Ordinance 1917."

THE SCHEDULE.

All that piece of land situated in the Township of Cooloon South (Tweed Heads) Parish of Terranora County of Rous containing Thirty-two and one half perches being Allotment 2 of Section 2 on Deposited Plan 2379 and being the whole of the lands comprised in Certificate of Title dated 10th August 1915 registered Volume 1626 Folio 178. Also all that piece of land situated in the Town Parish and County aforesaid containing One rood being Allotment 20 of Section 2 aforesaid and being the whole of the lands comprised in Certificate of Title date 11th July 1911 registered Volume 2161 Folio 229.
