TABULAM LAND SALE ORDINANCE 1922.

WHEREAS the lands more particularly described in the Schedule hereto are vested in the Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton AND WHEREAS it is expedient to sell the same and apply the proceeds as hereinafter directed BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED by the Synod of the Diocese of Grafton and by virtue of the powers in that behalf conferred by the Church of England Trust Property Act 1917 as follows—

1. THE CORPORATE TRUSTEES in whom the said lands are vested are hereby empowered and directed to sell the said lands either by public auction or private contract on such terms as they shall think fit with full power to execute the necessary Transfers and assurances for transferring and conveying the said lands to the purchasers thereof.

2. NO PURCHASER of the said lands under the powers here-by conferred shall be bound or concerned to enquire whether such power shall have been duly and properly exercised in accordance with the next preceding section or be affected by any notice to the contrary.

3. THE MONEYS arising out of such sale shall be applied to the cost of removing the existing Church to the new site provided for it within the Township of Tabulam to the fencing of the said site and to the erection of a Brothers' Lodge.

4. THIS ORDINANCE may be cited as the "Tabulam Land Sale Ordinance 1922."

THE SCHEDULE.

ALL THAT piece of land situated in the Parish of Tabulam County of Drake containing one rood being the whole of the land comprised in Crown Grant dated the twenty-ninth day of June 1900 registered volume 1322 folio 158 and being allotment four of section twenty-two of the Town of Tabulam.
