TYALGUM LAND SALE ORDINANCE, 1927

Whereas the lands more particularly described in the schedule hereto are vested in the Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton and whereas it is expedient to sell the same and to apply the proceeds as hereinafter directed. Be it therefore Ordained by the Synod of the Diocese of Grafton and by virtue of the Powers in that behalf conferred by the Church of England Trust (1) The Court of States of the Property Act 1917 as follows:—

(1) The Corporate Trustees in whom the said lands are vested are hereby empowered and directed to sell the said lands either

by public auction or private contract at such price and on such terms as they shall think fit with full power to execute the necessary transfers and assurances for giving effect to such sale.

(2) No purchaser of the said land shall be bound or concerned to inquire whether the powers hereby conferred have been duly and properly exercised or be affected by notice to the contrary.

(3) The moneys arising out of such sale shall be applied to the first place to defraying the expenses thereof, and the balance shall be expended towards the erection of a new church building on allotment 18, section 5, village of Tyalgum.

(4) This Ordinance may be cited as "The Tyalgum Land

Sale Ordinance 1927."

SCHEDULE.

All that piece of land, situated in the Parish of Tyalgua county of Rous, containing one rood, being the whole of the land comprised in certificate of title dated the twenty-first day of January 1911, registered volume 2117, folio 152, and being allotment 13 of section six in the village of Tyalgum, together with all buildings and appurtenances thereon.
