**CLERGY PROVIDENT FUND AMENDMENT ORDINANCE
1916.**

No. 4 OF 1916.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it has been deemed expedient to make some provision for the Assurance of Licensed Lay Readers in the Diocese who are or shall be candidates for Holy Orders in this Diocese and for that purpose to amend the Clergy Provident Fund Ordinance 1915: Be it therefore enacted by the Synod of the Diocese of Grafton as follows:—

Amendment.

1. That it shall be allowable by the Bishop-in-Council to grant from the Clergy Provident Fund of the Diocese an amount sufficient to provide an Accident and Sickness Policy under some Insurance Company approved by the Bishop-in-Council for Licensed Lay Readers, being candidates for Holy Orders, who are:—

- a. in charge of Parochial Districts, or
- b. assistants in Parochial work, under the direction of a Vicar or Locum Tenens of a Parish, or a Clerk-in-Charge of a Parochial District, until such time as such Readers become eligible for membership in Australian Clergy Provident Fund or Sydney Clergy Provident Fund according to the terms of Sections 11 and 12, Clergy Provident Fund Ordinance, 1915.

Short Title.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Clergy Provident Fund Amendment Ordinance 1916.
