

TASMANIA. DETERMINATION I., GENERAL SYNOD  
1916 (MA. OCTOBER 13, 1916).

Whereas it is expedient to amend Determination I. General Synod 1916 (made October 13, 1916) by it enacted by the Archbishops, Bishops, Clergy and Laity in General Synod assembled as follows:--

In clause one the following words "All vacancies occurring when the General Synod is not in session shall be filled by the person to whom the power of election is herein given. Provided that the Executive Committee of the General Synod shall in this respect act on behalf of the General Synod;" are hereby omitted and in lieu thereof the following words are hereby inserted, "All vacancies occurring when the General Synod is not in session shall be filled by the Board."

We hereby certify that the foregoing Determination was made by the General Synod of the Dioceses in Australia and Tasmania this twenty-sixth day of October, 1926.
