BROTHERHOOD AMENDMENT ORDINANCE 1916.No. 5 of 1916.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Brotherhood Ordinance 1915 by making provision for the raising of the Parochial District of Kyogle to the status of a Parish, whilst it remains in the territory served by "The Brotherhood of Our Saviour," and whereas the Parochial Council of Kyogle has undertaken, in lieu of the provision of a Vicarage House by them, to contribute, in regular instalments within a period of seven years the sum of £500 towards the purchase price of the Brotherhood Headquarters, and whereas it is desirable to secure the appointment of Vicars of Kyogle in due order.

Be it therefore ordained by the Synod of the Diocese of Grafton as follows:—

1. Notwithstanding anything contained in any Ordinance of Synod now or hereafter in force relating to the appointment of Clergy to Parishes, when and as often as the vacancy shall occur in the Parish of Kyogle, the Warden of the Brotherhood shall be the Vicar of that Parish, so long as the said Parish shall remain an integral part of the Brotherhood as defined in Section 2 of the said Ordinance, provided that on the vote of not less than a two-thirds majority of the Kyogle Parochial Council, the Parish of Kyogle may withdraw from the Brotherhood at the expiration of a period of two years from the date of the notification of such vote to the Bishop-in-Council; provided also that the Council of the Brotherhood shall, at the end of such period, refund to the Parochial Council of Kyogle such sum as the Parish may have contributed towards the purchase of the Brotherhood Headquarters.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as "The Brotherhood Ordinance Amendment Ordinance 1916."
