Amendment Ordinance, 1926

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE APPOINTMENT OF A DIOCESAN ARCHDEACON, 1926.

PREAMBLE.

WHEREAS a resolution of the Second Session of the Fifth Synod of the Diocese of Grafton, 1925, was passed requesting the Bishop to appoint a Diocesan Archdeacon, BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the Synod of the Diocese of Grafton that—

1. Of the Archdeacons appointed by the Bishop, one may be set free from Parochial responsibilities to perform such duties as the Bishop shall direct.
2. The Bishop-in-Council is empowered to make such provision as shall be deemed necessary for the support and travelling expenses of such Archdeacon from any funds at the disposal of the said Bishop-in-Council, or of the Bishop.
3. This Ordinance may be cited as 'The Diocesan Archdeacon's Appointment Ordinance, 1926.'
