

SOUTH WOODBURN LAND SALE (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE 1927

PREAMBLE

WHEREAS by the South Woodburn Land Sale Ordinance 1918 provision is made for the disposal and allocation of the moneys to be derived from the Sale of the land described in the Schedule thereto and whereas it has become inexpedient to vary the provisions contained in Section three of the said Ordinance and it is in the opinion of the Council of the Diocese of Grafton desirable to amend the same. Be it therefore ordained by the Council of the Diocese of Grafton in exercise of the powers granted and conferred by Section 32 of the Church of England Trust Property Act 1917 and by the Delegation of Powers Ordinance 1918 as follows:-

Amendment

1. Section 3 of the 'South Woodburn Land Sale Ordinance 1918' is hereby amended by deleting in line two the words 'removal and reerection of the church' and by inserting in lieu thereof the words 'erection of a Vicarage'.
