- (g) To arrange, with the approval of the Bishop-in-Council, for all appeals on behalf of the Diocesan Education project. Fund or in connection with any fresh educational
- (h) To promote the training of candidates for Holy Orders for this Diocese.
- (i) To arrange for the carrying out of any other business connected with Diocesan education submitted by the

BY-LAWS.
