

ORDINANCE PASSED BY SYNOD.

DORRIGO LAND SALE ORDINANCE 1920.

WHEREAS the lands more particularly described in the schedule hereto are vested in the Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton having been purchased out of the moneys belonging to the Church Extension Fund of the said Diocese AND WHEREAS no use has been found for the said lands and it is expedient to sell the same and apply the proceeds as hereinafter directed: Be it therefore ordained by the Synod of the Diocese of Grafton and by virtue of the powers in that behalf conferred by the Church of England Trust Property Act 1917 as follows:—

1. The Corporate Trustees in whom the said lands are vested are hereby empowered and directed to sell the said lands either by Public Auction or private contract on such terms as they shall think fit with full power to execute the necessary transfers and assurances for transferring and conveying the said lands to the purchasers thereof.

2. No purchaser of the said lands under the powers hereby conferred shall be bound or concerned to enquire whether such power shall have been duly and properly exercised in accordance with the next preceding Section or be affected by any notice to the contrary.

3. The moneys arising out of such sale shall be applied in the first place to the repayment of the sum of one hundred and seventy-two pounds ten shillings (£172 10s) to the Church Extension Fund Capital Account and the remainder of the said moneys shall be paid to the Church Extension Fund Income Account of the said Diocese.

4. This Ordinance may be cited as the "Dorrigo Land Sale Ordinance 1920."

The Schedule.

All that piece of land situated in the County of Fitzroy Parish of Bligh containing one acre one rood and thirteen and one-half perches being the whole of the lands comprised in Certificate of Title dated the seventh day of May 1915

Registered Volume 2572 folio 238 being allotments ten and fifteen of section sixteen of the village of Dorrigo. I assent to this Ordinance.
