

GLADSTONE LAND SALE ORDINANCE 1923.

WHEREAS the lands more particularly described in the schedule hereto are vested in the Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton AND WHEREAS it is expedient to sell the same and apply the proceeds as hereinafter directed BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED by the Synod of the Diocese of Grafton and by virtue of the powers in that behalf conferred by the Church of England Trust Property Act 1917 as follows:—

1. THE CORPORATE TRUSTEES in whom the said lands are vested are hereby empowered and directed to sell the said lands either by public auction or private contract on such terms as they shall think fit with full power to execute the necessary Transfers and assurances for transferring and conveying the said lands to the purchasers thereof.
2. NO PURCHASER of the said lands under the powers hereby conferred shall be bound or concerned to enquire whether such power shall have been duly and properly exercised in accordance with the next preceding section or be affected by any notice to the contrary.
3. THE MONEYS arising out of such sale shall be applied to the cost of purchasing another site in the Township of Gladstone to be vested in the Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton and towards the erection of a Church thereon.
4. THIS ORDINANCE may be cited as the "Gladstone Land Sale Ordinance 1923."

THE SCHEDULE.

ALL THAT piece of land situated in the Town of Gladstone Parish of Kinchela County of Macquarie containing twenty four perches being the whole of the land comprised in Certificate of Title dated the Twenty-ninth day of October 1919 registered Volume 2984 Folio 188.
