WHEREAS by Ordinance bearing date the 6th day of December One thousand nine hundred and twenty-three and cited as "The Kyogle Land Sale Ordinance 1923" the Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton were empowered (inter alia) to lay out and dedicate as a public lane or way certain land therein mentioned AND WHEREAS the Council of the Shire of Kyogle has declined to approve of such dedication but has signified its acceptance of the land and right of way hereinafter described AND WHEREAS it is expedient that clause two of the said recited Ordinance be repealed and clause two hereof substituted therefor. BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED by the Council of the Diocese of Grafton under and by virtue of the powers conferred by the Church of England Trust Property Act 1917 and by the Delegation of Powers Ordinance 1918 as follows:—

- 1. That Clause two of the Kyogle Land Sale Ordinance 1923 is hereby repealed and clause two hereof substituted therefor.
- 2. The said Corporate Trustees are also hereby authorised and empowered to lay out and dedicate as a public lane or way a strip of land twenty feet wide passing along and within the eastern boundaries of Lots 205 and 206 and also to lay out a right of way twelve feet wide within Lot 205 as shown on plan of subdivision of Mr. Surveyor MacCallum and approved by the Council of the Shire of Kyogle on the eleventh day of June One thousand nine hundred and twenty-four Certificate number 57 and to

make sign and execute all such applications deeds documents and assurances for this purpose giving effect to such laying out and designation.

3. This Ordinance may be cited as "The Kyogl; Land Sale Amending Ordinance 1925."
