

## CHURCH FINANCE ORDINANCE AMENDMENT ORDINANCE, 1926.

WHEREAS it is desirable to amend the Church Finance Ordinance of 1925, to provide if deemed advisable for dealing with long standing arrears of Parochial Assessment, be it therefore enacted by the Synod of the Diocese of Grafton as follows:—

### AMENDMENT.

1. That a new clause be inserted to read:—
  11. "That an appeal board, consisting of the Bishop-ex-officio, the Archdeacons, the Treasurer of the Diocese, and one lay member, elected by the Bishop-in-Council from amongst its number be appointed to consider the cases of Parishes that shall appeal for help on the grounds that because of special difficulties they are unable to meet long-standing arrears of assessment, and report with recommendations to the Bishop-in-Council, which Council after such report has been

considered shall have power if it think fit to grant whatever financial relief may be desirable and possible."

**SHORT TITLE.**

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the "Church Finance Ordinance Amendment Ordinance, 1926."
