

# Wiangaree Land Exchange Confirming Ordinance, 1985

## PREAMBLE

WHEREAS the land described in Part I of the Schedule hereto is vested in the Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton AND WHEREAS under the authority of a resolution of the Council of the said Diocese the said Corporate Trustees have effected an exchange of the said land for the land described in Part II of the same Schedule AND WHEREAS it is desirable that such exchange should be confirmed NOW and the powers in that behalf conferred upon it by the Church of England Trust Property Act, 1947, and the provision of the Church of England Trust Property Ordinance, 1984, appointing the Council of the Diocese of Grafton for the purposes of exercising during the recess of Synod the powers and functions of the said Ordinance referred to and in pursuance of the powers vested in the said Synod by the constitutions for the management and good government of the Church of England within the State of New South Wales or otherwise in the name and place of such Synod ordains, declares and rules as follows:

1. The exchange of the land in Part I of the Schedule hereto for the land in Part II of the same Schedule is hereby ratified and confirmed.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Wiangaree Land Exchange Confirming Ordinance, 1985.

## THE SCHEDULE

### PART I—

ALL that piece of land containing 1 acre 2 rood 26 perches situated in the County of Ross Parish and Village of Wiangaree being portion 86, and being the whole of the lands comprised in Crown Grant Registered Book Volume 2866, Folio 15.

### PART II—

ALL that piece of land containing 2 roods more or less situated in the County of Ross Parish and Village of Wiangaree being parts of allotments 77 and 78, section 10.
