## PORT MACQUARIE LAND SALE ORDINANCE, 1926

WHEREAS the lands more particularly described in the Schedul hereto are vested in the Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grantan AND WHEREAS it is expedient to sell the same and apply the process as hereinafter directed BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED by the Synod the Diocese of Grafton and by virtue of the powers in that behalf and the Church of England Trust Property Act 1917 as follows:

1. The Corporate Trustees in whom the said lands are vested are her by empowered and directed to sell the said lands either by public and or private contract on such terms as they shall think fit with full pow to execute the necessary transfers and assurances for transferring and enveying the said lands to the purchasers thereof.

2. No purchasers of the said lands shall be bound or concerned to quire whether such power shall have been duly and properly exercised accordance with the next preceding section or be affected by any not

3. The moneys arising out of such sale shall be applied in the place to defraying the expenses thereof and in the next place in the erection of a Vicarage within the Parish of Port Macquarie and keeps the same in repair.

4. This Ordinance may be cited as "Port Macquarie Land Sale
