

Bush Brotherhood Land Ordinance,

1923.

WHEREAS the land described in the schedule hereto is situated within the Parish of Kyogle and has hitherto been held by the Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton in trust for the purposes of "The Brotherhood of our Saviour" created by "The Brotherhood Ordinance 1915," AND WHEREAS it is desirable and the Council of the said Brotherhood has requested that the said trusts be varied as hereinafter appears BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED by the Council of the Diocese of Grafton under and by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 32 of the Church of England Trust Property Act 1917 and by the Delegation of Powers Ordinance 1918 as follows:—

1. It is declared that in the opinion of the Council of the Diocese of Grafton exercising the aforesaid powers it has become inexpedient to carry out or observe the existing trusts in relation to the land described in the schedule hereto or to deal with or apply the said land or any part thereof for the purposes of the Brotherhood of our Saviour.

2. The said trusts are hereto determined so far as they relate to the said land.

3. The said lands shall henceforth be held as Parochial land in trust for general Church purposes within the Parish of Kyogle in the said Diocese.

4. This Ordinance may be cited as "The Bush Brotherhood Land Ordinance, 1923."

THE SCHEDULE.

ALL THAT piece or parcel of land containing two acres one rood and two perches situated at Kyogle in the Parish of Fairymount and County of Rous being the whole of the land comprised in Certificate of Title dated the eighteenth day of May One thousand nine hundred and seven registered volume 1778, folio 146.
