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YAMBA LAND SALE CONFIRMING ORDINANCE

1926.

WHEREAS by Ordinance cited as the " Yamba Land Sale Ordinance 1916 " the Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton were empowered and directed to sell the lands described in the Schedule hereto AND WHEREAS by Ordinance cited as the " Yamba Land Sale Amendment Ordinance 1917 " it was ordained that the said land should be held upon trust for the appropriation thereof as a Glebe annexed to the Church of England erected or to be erected at Yamba AND WHEREAS it has since been deemed expedient to sell the said lands and such lands have been sold and the proceeds of the sale thereof have been applied in the reduction of a loan out of funds belonging to the Diocese, made to the Parish within which the said lands are situated AND WHEREAS no Ordinance has been promulgated empowering the said Corporate Trustees to sell the said lands or authorising the application of the said proceeds of sale BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Diocese of Grafton under and by virtue of the powers conferred by the Church of England Trust Property Act 1917 and by the Delegation of Powers Ordinance 1918 as follows :-

- 1 : The said sale and the application of the proceeds thereof as aforesaid be and the same is hereby ratified and confirmed.
- 2 : This Ordinance may be known and cited as the " Yamba Land Sale Confirming Ordinance 1926."

THE SCHEDULE.

ALL THAT piece of land containing Twenty perches situated in the County of Clarence Parish and Town of Yamba being part of Allotment nine Section ten and being the whole of the land comprised in Certificate of Title dated the 3rd May 1897 Volume 1218 Folio 29.
