

CASINO GRAMMAR SCHOOL VARIATION OF TRUST ORDINANCE, 1926.

WHEREAS the land described in the Schedule hereto is vested in the Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton AND WHEREAS by Declaration of Trust bearing date of Twelfth day of December one thousand nine hundred and eighteen it was declared that the said land was held by the said Corporate Trustees in trust for the Board of Management of the Casino Church of England Grammar School AND WHEREAS by reason of circumstances which have arisen subsequent to the creation of the said trust it has become inexpedient to carry out or observe the said trust and it is desirable that the said trust be altered or varied as hereinafter set forth BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Diocese of Grafton under and by virtue of the powers conferred by the Church of England Trust Property Act 1917 and by Delegation of the Powers Ordinance 1918 as follows:—

1. The said land shall henceforth be held by the said Corporate Trustees in trust for the purpose of establishing and maintaining hostels and for education generally within the Diocese of Grafton under the supervision of the Bishop-in-Council of the said Diocese and hereinbefore recited trust and all other trusts hereinbefore declared to the contrary notwithstanding.

2. This Ordinance shall be known and cited as "Casino Grammar School Variation of Trust Ordinance 1926."

THE SCHEDULE.

ALL THAT piece or parcel of land containing by admeasurement Five Acres Two Roods and Eighteen Perches be the same more or less situated in the County of Rous and Parish of North Casino Town of Casino Section twenty-four "A" Commencing on the South-Easterly intersection of Richmond and Diary Streets at a point bearing South and distant one hundred and fifty links from the South-West corner of section number twenty-four and bounded thence on the West by Diary Street Southerly at right angles to Richmond Street three chains and seventy-five links to the Richmond River on the South by the Richmond River downward to the West side of West Street on the East by West Street Northerly six chains to Richmond Street and on the North by Richmond Street Westerly at right angles to West Street ten chains to the point of commencement being the land selected under the Regulations of Eleventh February 1851.
