GRAFTON GLEBE LAND LEASE ORDINANCE 1928.

PRAEMBLE.

WHEREAS the lands described in the Schedule hereto are vested in the Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton AND WHEREAS it is desired that the said lands be leased in order that they may become revenue producing

BE IT THEREFORE ordained by the Council of the Diocese of Grafton under and by virtue of the powers conferred by the Church of England Trust Property Act 1917 and by the Delegation of Powers Ordinance 1918 as follows:-

1. The Corporate Trustees in whom the said lands are vested are hereby authorised and empowered to lease the said lands for a period not exceeding fifty years upon such conditions as they shall think fit.
2. The said Corporate Trustees are hereby empowered to execute all necessary deeds and documents and to do all things required for the purpose of giving effect to such lease.
3. This Ordinance may be cited as the "Grafton Glebe Land Lease Ordinance 1928".

THE SCHEDULE.

ALL that piece or parcel of land containing two roods fourteen perches more or less situated in the County of Clarence Parish of Great Marlow and City of Grafton being Allotment number two of Section number five.
