

DECLARATION OF TRUST – MULLUMBIMBY PARISH

DECLARATION OF TRUST made the **6th** day of **July 2017** by the Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton (hereinafter called "the Trustees") pursuant to section 19 of the Anglican Church of Australia Trust Property Act 1917 and section 164 of the Grafton Diocesan Governance Ordinance 2008.

WHEREAS

- a. The Trustees hold certain monies upon trust for the Parish of **Mullumbimby** arising from the sale of the former St Anselm Church at Ocean Shores.
- b. The sale of the above property was permitted by The Parish of Mullumbimby Ocean Shores Land Sale Ordinance 2014 where the net proceeds after allocation to the Bishop's Appeal for Sustainable Ministry is to be held in trust "for the general purposes of the Parish as determined by resolution of the Parish Council and approved by Bishop-in-Council".

NOW THIS DEED WITNESSETH as follows:

The monies held, after defraying all liabilities, costs, charges and expenses is declared to be held and applied by the Trustees in the manner following, that is to say:

- a. The said monies are vested in and administered by the said Trustees and will known as the **Mullumbimby Parish Endowment**.
- b. The net amount of the **Mullumbimby Parish Endowment** shall be held in trust for the general purposes of the **Parish of Mullumbimby**.
