

DECLARATION OF TRUST – BYRON BAY PARISH

DECLARATION OF TRUST made the **17th** day of **March 2016** by the Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton (hereinafter called “the Trustees”) pursuant to section 19 of the Anglican Church of Australia Trust Property Act 1917 and section 164 of the Grafton Diocesan Governance Ordinance 2008.

WHEREAS

- a. The Trustees hold certain monies upon trust for the Parish of **Byron Bay** in a trust accounts known as the **Whipps Bequest**.
- b. Probate on The Estate of Doris Amy Elizabeth Whipps was declared on 21 June 1995 where the recognised Last Will and Testament of the testator provided for “As to a one-half share thereof to the Rector of St Pauls Church of England Byron Bay, to be used for parish purposes as the Rector shall see fit”.

NOW THIS DEED WITNESSETH as follows:

The monies held, after defraying all liabilities, costs, charges and expenses is declared to be held and applied by the Trustees in the manner following, that is to say:

- a. The said monies are vested in and administered by the said Trustees and will known as the **Whipps Bequest**.
- b. The net amount of the **Whipps Bequest** shall be held in trust for the general purposes of the Parish of **Byron Bay** that have the support of the Rector of the parish.
