

DECLARATION OF TRUST – GRAFTON PARISH

DECLARATION OF TRUST made the **5th** day of **July 2018** by the Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton (hereinafter called “the Trustees”) pursuant to section 19 of the Anglican Church of Australia Trust Property Act 1917 and section 164 of the Grafton Diocesan Governance Ordinance 2008.

WHEREAS

- a. The Trustees hold certain monies upon trust for the Parish of **Grafton** arising from the sale of lands at **415 Cambridge Street Copmanhurst** which in accordance with the Copmanhurst Land Sale Ordinance 2011 are set aside “for the provision of ministry in the Copmanhurst area”.
- b. The Trustees hold certain monies upon trust for the Parish of **Grafton** arising from the sale of certain lands at **Copmanhurst** which in accordance with the Copmanhurst Land Sale Ordinance 1990 are to erect an amenities block at Holy Apostles’ Church, Copmanhurst and the balance “placed on trust for the Maintenance and Future Development of Holy Apostles’ Church, Copmanhurst and for Ministry in the Copmanhurst area”.
- c. It is expedient for the Trustees to amalgamate the above trusts into a single trust known as the **Copmanhurst Endowment**.
- d. The terms of the **Copmanhurst Endowment** supersede and replace any terms or conditions of the individual amalgamated trusts.

NOW THIS DEED WITNESSETH as follows:

The monies held, after defraying all liabilities, costs, charges and expenses is declared to be held and applied by the Trustees in the manner following, that is to say:

- a. The said monies are vested in and administered by the said Trustees and will known as the **Copmanhurst Endowment**.
- b. The net amount of the **Copmanhurst Endowment** shall be held in trust for the Parish of **Grafton** for the purpose of its ministry in Copmanhurst.
