

DECLARATION OF TRUST – KINGSCLIFF PARISH

DECLARATION OF TRUST made the 7th day of **November 2019** by the Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton (hereinafter called “the Trustees”) pursuant to section 19 of the Anglican Church of Australia Trust Property Act 1917 and section 164 of the Grafton Diocesan Governance Ordinance 2008.

WHEREAS


- a. The Trustees hold certain monies upon trust arising from the estate of the late John Herbert (Jack) Davey.
- b. Mr Davey bequeathed the monies for the purpose of the Parish of Kingscliff and expressed a wish that the funds be used for the roofing and restumping of the church of St Michael and All Angels at Burringbar.
- c. The church of St Michael and All Angels Burringbar was deconsecrated and subsequently sold in accordance with The Parish of Kingscliff Burringbar Land Sale Ordinance 2011.

NOW THIS DEED WITNESSETH as follows:


The monies held, after defraying all liabilities, costs, charges and expenses is declared to be held and applied by the Trustees in the manner following, that is to say:

- a. The said monies are vested in and administered by the said Trustees and will be known as the **Kingscliff Parish Endowment**.
- b. The net amount of the **Kingscliff Parish Endowment** shall be held in trust for the general purposes of the **Parish of Kingscliff**.
