DECLARATION OF TRUST – BYRON PARISH

DECLARATION OF TRUST made the **5**th day of **November 2020** by the Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton (hereinafter called "the Trustees") pursuant to section 19 of the Anglican Church of Australia Trust Property Act 1917 and section 164 of the Grafton Diocesan Governance Ordinance 2008.

WHEREAS

- a. The Trustees hold certain monies upon trust for the Parish of Byron Bay in a trust account known as Estate of ER Alexander.
- b. The terms of the Estate of ER Alexander trust were confirmed in a Declaration of Trust made on 17 February 2006.
- c. In 2020, the Parish of Byron Bay combined with the Parish of Bangalow and the Parish of Mullumbimby to form the Parish of Byron. The entity Parish of Byron Bay ceased to exist.
- d. This declaration supersedes and replaces the earlier declaration of trust.

NOW THIS DEED WITNESSETH as follows:

The monies held, after defraying all liabilities, costs, charges and expenses is declared to be held and applied by the Trustees in the manner following, that is to say:

- a. The said monies are vested in and administered by the said Trustees and will be known as the **Estate of ER Alexander**.
- b. The net amount of the **Estate of ER Alexander** shall be held in trust for the **Parish of Byron** for the purpose of "creating in the children of the relevant Parishes a love for the scriptures through the Bible itself".
