

DECLARATION OF TRUST – BYRON PARISH

DECLARATION OF TRUST made the 17th day of **December 2020** by the Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton (hereinafter called “the Trustees”) pursuant to section 19 of the Anglican Church of Australia Trust Property Act 1917 and section 164 of the Grafton Diocesan Governance Ordinance 2008.

WHEREAS

- a. Anglican Funds Grafton Diocese hold four separate funds on behalf of the former Parish of Mullumbimby for the purpose of organ related expenses at St Martin’s Church.
- b. The Mullumbimby Organ Fund, Organ Fund A, Organ Fund B and Organ Fund C, were substantially funded from the estate of the Late Clara Smith (2012) for the purposes of the organ fund.
- c. In 2020, the Parish of Mullumbimby combined with the Parish of Byron Bay and the Parish of Bangalow to form the Parish of Byron. The entity Parish of Mullumbimby ceased to exist.
- d. This declaration is a new declaration of trust.

NOW THIS DEED WITNESSETH as follows:

The monies held, after defraying all liabilities, costs, charges and expenses is declared to be held and applied by the Trustees in the manner following, that is to say:

- a. The said monies are vested in and administered by the said Trustees and will be known as the **St Martin’s Church Mullumbimby Organ Trust**.
- b. The net amount of the **St Martin’s Church Mullumbimby Organ Trust** shall be held in trust for the purposes of the upkeep, care and related expenses of the organ at St Martin’s Church, Mullumbimby in the **Parish of Byron**.
