

WHEREAS WE did lately receive a Petition from the Reverend Ronald James Hancock, Rector of the Parish of Ballina, and the Churchwardens of the Church of St. Mary, Ballina, praying that we would be vithue of our Episcopal Authority grant a Faculty for the articles mentioned below to be placed in the Church of St. Mary, Ballina.

- 1) A Board to give notice of the Sunday in the Church Year,  
to be inscribed: "To the Glory of God and in loving memory  
of Brian Overatt, died 23.10.60."
- 2) Two Silver Flagon for the use of holding water and wine,  
to be inscribed: "To the Glory of God and in loving memory  
of Peter James Fraser, Deacon, died 25.4.62."
- 3) A remote Console for the Pipe Organ, to be inscribed:  
"The Organ Console is dedicated to the Glory  
of God and in loving memory of Frederick  
George Cullen (Warden of this Church), died  
23.4.56, and his wife, Alice Edith, died  
1.3.42."

WHEREAS these articles appear to be fitting and seemly to be placed within the House of God.

NOW THEREFORE, WE, ROBERT GONDOL, by Divine Providence, BISHOP OF GRAFTON, do hereby grant this our Faculty and give consent to the abovementioned proposal.
