FACULTY

WHEREAS WE did lately receive a Petition from The Reverend **GARY ROY ATHERTON** of the Parish of **SOUTH GRAFTON** and the Churchwardens of **ST MATTHEW'S ANGLICAN CHURCH** at **SOUTH GRAFTON** praying that we would by virtue of our Episcopal Authority, grant a Faculty for the below-mentioned addition to the Church at **SOUTH GRAFTON**

A wooden lectern; a wooden prayer desk; a wooden chair; a wooden altar, 150cm long and 45cm wide, complete with two wooden candleholders 30cm high; a wooden shelf, 150cm long and 16cm wide, attached to the southern wall behind the altar; a wooden cross, 81cm high and 46cm wide, hung on the southern wall above the shelf; a picture of St Luke's OBX Creek, as well as a brief outline of its history, hung on the eastern wall; and a brass memorial plaque 7.5cm high and 13cm long, attached to the eastern wall, on the left hands side of the wooden door, engraved with the words: "The Chapel of St Luke Dedicated to the glory of God in loving memory of Alma Dart 15/9/1915 – 28/4/2002 on the 5/6/2005"

WHEREAS this addition appears to be fitting and appropriate to be undertaken in the Anglican Church at **SOUTH GRAFTON**.

NOW THEREFORE, WE, KEITH FRANCIS by Divine Providence

BISHOP OF GRAFTON do grant this our Faculty and give consent to the abovementioned proposal.
