CROSS AS APPROVED TO BE PLACED ON THE ALTAR TO REPLACE  
PRESENT CROSS THEREON. PRESENT CROSS TO BE CONVERTED  
TO PROCESSIONAL CROSS AND PLACED IN SANCTUARY.

WHEREAS this alteration appears to be fitting and seemly to be made to the House of God.

NOW THEREFORE, WE, ROBERT GORDON, by Divine Providence, BISHOP OF GRAFTON, do hereby grant this our faculty and give consent to the abovementioned proposal.
