Memorial
ALUMINIUM CROSS

A cross to be placed on the outside of the east wall at the sanctuary end, in memory of the late Norman Barrett. The cross to be painted and made of aluminium, with fluorescent lighting, size 16 feet by 8 feet, about 4" square in width and depth, and standing out 3 inches or 4 inches from the wall.

NOW THEREFORE, WE, ROBERT GORDON, by Divine Providence BISHOP OF GRAFTON do grant this our Faculty and give consent to the above-named proposal.
