- The Bishop
- Diocesan Archdeacon
- The Dean
- Regional Archdeacons
- Mission Support Officers
- Other members by invitation of the Bishop

The Senior Clergy Team will:

- Have a heart for God's mission and how it can be lived out in Grafton Diocese
- Foster and facilitate cultural change informed by the Vision and Values of the Diocese
- Model collaborative ministry and a shared approach to leadership
- Model leadership that is visionary, strategic, authentic and of high integrity
- Foster and promote a professional approach to ministry and a confidence that Christian ministry has something of value to offer
- Offer a voice and insight into issues in Ministry Units and in the wider diocese
- Offer options for intervention where there are issues in Ministry Unit
- Listen to the mood of the Diocese
- Promote a healthy and safe culture where everyone can flourish
- Be a sounding board for the Bishop and offer ideas and feedback
- Be a forum to facilitate the pastoral care of clergy and other leaders
- Facilitate information sharing and effective communication with Ministry Units and model clear, effective communication
- Honour and utilise the gifts of team members
- Be committed to ongoing professional development and personal and spiritual growth in Christ
- Offer personal witness to the Christian faith from which our living, vision and values are derived.
