

**MULLUMBIMBY RECTORY PROPERTY ORDINANCE 2016  
AMENDING ORDINANCE 2021  
Ordinance No. 5 of 2021**

An Amending Ordinance to vary the use of the proceeds of sale of the former Rectory at Stuart Street, Mullumbimby in the former Parish of Mullumbimby, Diocese of Grafton.

**PREAMBLE**

**Whereas** the Mullumbimby Rectory Property Ordinance 2016 was passed by Bishop-in-Council on the Eighth Day of December 2016.

**Whereas** the former Parish of Mullumbimby has been incorporated into the Parish of Byron and the use of funds as per the 2016 Ordinance is no longer expedient,

**Therefore**, the Bishop-in-Council in pursuance of powers provided in clause 48.2 of the Diocesan Governance Ordinance 2008 hereby decrees and enacts as follows:

**AMENDMENT**

1. Clause 4 of the Mullumbimby Rectory Property Ordinance 2016 is replaced by the following:


"The money arising out of such sale shall be paid to The Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton and, after provision has been made for all costs charges and expenses relating thereto, 85% of the proceeds shall be allocated to the Diocesan Financial Challenge trust, 0.7% for Sustainable Development Goals, and the balance to the Byron Parish Endowment. The funds may be held with and merged with other trust accounts."

**SHORT TITLE**

This Ordinance may be cited as the Mullumbimby Rectory Property Amending Ordinance 2021.
