Safe Ministry Screening and Risk Assessment

Information for Incumbents and Churchwardens undertaking Safe Ministry Screening.

- 1. New members of Parish Councils (including Churchwardens) must have a completed and verified Working With Children Check and a screened Safe Ministry Form before commencing as a member of Parish Council (GEN006 Background Checks and Minimum Training Standards for Community Protection sections 3.2.2 (a) and 3.3.2(a)).
- 2. All the answers provided on Safe Ministry forms for volunteers must be screened by the Incumbent assisted by a Churchwarden (GEN006 Background Checks and Minimum Training Standards for Community Protection sections 3.2.2 (a) and 3.3.2(e)).
- **3.** Where the reviewers have concerns or form the view that the appointment should not be made or should not continue, a recommendation can be made to the Bishop. Prior to taking this step, advice should be sought from the Director of Professional Standards.
