FACULTY

WHEREAS WE did lately receive a Petition from the Reverend Alfred John Gerlach, Rector of the Parish of Bellingen, and the Churchwardens of St. Margaret's Church, Bellingen, praying that we would by virtue of our Episcopal Authority grant a Faculty for the following alterations and additions, mentioned below, to be made to the Church of St. Margaret's, Bellingen:

TWO STAINED GLASS WINDOWS

- (1) To be erected in the ecclesiastical East end of the Church above the Communion Table, depicting our Lord risen, and adored by Mary Magdalene.  
Inscribed as follows: "To the Glory of God and in loving memory of Margaret Ann Raymond, wife of Augustus Mead Raymond, 1870 - 1954."
- (2) To be erected on the extreme right hand in the Baptistery and depicting St. Margaret of Scotland (in honour of whom the Church is dedicated).  
Inscribed as follows: "A.M.D.G. and in memory of Mary Jane Elizabeth Moody, obit, 17.11.1959."

WHEREAS THESE alterations and additions appear to be fitting to be made to the House of God.

NOW THEREFORE, WE, ROBERT GORDON, by Divine Providence BISHOP OF GRAFTON, do grant this our Faculty and give consent to the abovementioned proposal.
