Faculty for the following alterations and additions, mentioned below, to be made
to the Church of St. Margaret's, Bellingen:

THO STAINED GLASS WINDOWS

- (1) To be erected in the ecclesiastical East end of the Church above the Communion Table, depicting our Lord risen, and adored by Mary Madgalene.

 Inacribed as follows: "To the Glory of God and in loving memory of Margaret Ann Eaymond, wife of Augustus Mead Raymond, 1870 1954."
- (2) To be erected on the extreme right hand in the Bapistry and depicting St. Margarot of Scotland (in honour of whom the Church is dedicated).

 Inscribed as follows: "A.M.D.G. and in memory of Mary Jane Elizabeth Moody, oblit, 17.11.1959."

WHEREAS THESE alterations and additions appear to be fitting to be made to the House of God.

MON THEREFORE, WE, ROBERT GORDON, by Divine Providence BISHOP OF GRAFTON, do grant this our Faculty and give consent to the abovementioned proposal.
