

FACULTY

WHEREAS we did lately receive a Petition from the Very Reverend Arthur Edward Mann, Dean of Christ Church Cathedral in the Parish of Grafton, and the Churchwardens of Christ Church Cathedral, Grafton, praying that we would by virtue of our Episcopal Authority grant a Faculty for the alteration to the Chapel of the Epiphany at Christ Church Cathedral, Grafton, as set out below.

TO REMOVE FROM THE CHAPEL OF THE EPIPHANY THE BRICK CAIRN AND TO SUBSTITUTE THEREFOR A SHELF OF GOODLY DESIGN ON WHICH TO PLACE THE BOOK OF MEMORY, ALSO TO REMOVE FROM ITS PRESENT POSITION THE MEMORIAL LIGHT AND INSTAL IT CLOSER TO THE CHAPEL ALTER.

WHEREAS this alteration appears to be fitting and seemly to be made to the House of God.

NOW THEREFORE, WE, ROBERT GORDON, by Divine Providence, BISHOP OF GRAFTON, do hereby grant this our faculty and give consent to the abovementioned proposal.
