WHEREAS WE did lately receive a Petition from the Rev. Canon R.J. Hancock Rector of the Parish of Kempsey and the Churchwardens of All Saints' Church at Kempsey, praying that we would be virtue of our Episcopal Authority grant a Faculty for the articles mentioned below, to be placed in All Saints' Church, Kempsey.

Seven Shields with the Coat of Arms of the following dioceses: Canterbury, London, Calcutta, Australia, Newcastle, Grafton-Armidale, and Grafton. These are to hang in the screen which stands against the Western wall behind the Font.

A silver plate will also be installed with the inscription: "The shields were made and given by the Venerable A.E. Warr, in memory of ARTHUR BROUGHTON TRESE, Archdeacon and Rector of Kempsey, 1928-19 ."

WHEREAS these articles appear to be fitting and seemly to be placed in the House of God,

NOW THEREFORE, WE, DONALD NORMAN, by Divine Providence BISHOP OF GRAFTON do grant this our Faculty and give consent to the abovementioned proposal.
