## DETAILS ATTACHED TO FACULTY FOR ALTERATIONS TO ST. MARGARET'S CHURCH AT BELLINGEN

- 1. Extend the sanctuary area to the former chancel step.
- 2. Move Altar to site of altar rails.
- 3. Place lectern and font within extended sanctuary area in front of, and either side of, the Altar.
- 4. Place organ at rear of the Church (site formerly of Font).
- 5. Convert organ bay to a chapel by removing old pulpit to give access, and place prayer desks and aumbry in the chapel.

  (Aumbry with white sanctuary lamp above it in memory of Sadie Wolfe and Bob Wolfe and the former Altar Gravine shelf fitted below it).
- 5. "Noble" memorial to be transferred from pulpit to panelling in the chapel.
- 7. Bishop's chair to a "presidential position on top step where Altar had been.
- 8. Priest's chair to flexible position beside Altar.
