did lately receive a Petition from The Reverend IVAN JOHN SHEPHERD Rector of the Parish of KYOGLE and the Churchwardens of ST. JAMES Church at KYOGLE, praying that we would by virtue of our Episcopal Authority, grant a Faculty for the belowmentioned additions in ST. JAMES Church, KYOGLE.

THAT AN AUMBRY BE ATTACHED INTO THE WALL OF THE SANCTUARY ON THE GOSPEL SIDE, APPROXIMATELY (1m & 370mm) FROM THE FLOOR. BRICKS WOULD BE REMOVED CAREFULLY BY A SKILLED TRADESMAN, ALLOWING FOR THE PLACEMENT OF THE STRONG METAL AUMBRY, (280mm) HIGH, (242mm) WIDE AND (178mm) DEEP. THE DOOR CARRYING A LOCK WOULD BE OF BRASS. THE WOULD CARRY A CROSS. IN THE AUMBRY WOULD BE PLACED THE RESERVED EUCHARIST AND HOLY OILS. AN AUMBRY LAMP (ELECTRIC) WOULD BE LOCATED A LITTLE ABOVE THE AUMBRY TO INDICATE THE PRESENCE OF THE SACRED ELEMENTS.

WHEREAS

these additions appear to be fitting and appropriate to be undertaken in ST. JAMES Church, KYOGLE.

NOW THEREFORE, WE, BRUCE ALLAN by Divine Providence

BISHOP OF GRAFTON do grant this our Faculty and give consent to the abovementioned proposal.
