WHEREAS WE did lately receive a Petition from the Reverend Keith Mervyn McDonald, Rector of Murwillumbah and the Churchwardens of All Saints' Church at Murwillumbah, praying that we would by virtue of our Episcopal Authority grant a Faculty for the articles mentioned below to be placed in All Saints' Church, Murwillumbah.

AN AMBRY TO CONTAIN THE RESERVE COMMUNION FOR CHURCH MEMBERS IN THE HIGH ALTAR ROOM. IT IS TO BE MADE IN BRASS WITH ADJACENT TO THE ALTAR. APPROXIMATELY 10" x 7".

A STANDARD PROFESSIONAL CANDLESHELD OF BRASS TO BE PLACED IN CHURCH IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CHURCH OF ENGLAND CANONICALS AND REGULATIONS AND REPAIRING OLD CHURCH RECORDS - 1974-5.

A "RESURRECTION" CANDLESHELD TO BE PLACED IN CHURCH AS A REMINDING DESIGN WITH THE ALTAR. IT IS TO BE PLACED AT THE FRONT AND USED IN THE CHURCH DURING THE REVISED BAPTISMAL RITE USED IN THE CHURCH IN 1974-5. THE GIFT OF THE JOHNSON FAMILY IN MEMORY OF THEIR FATHER.

WHEREAS these articles appear to be fitting and seemly to be placed in the House of God.

AND WHEREAS, WE, EDWARD NORMAN by Divine Providence BISHOP OF GRAFTON do grant this our Faculty and give consent to the abovementioned proposal.
