WHEREAS WE did lately receive a Petition from the Reverend Barry William Harris, Rector of the Parish of Woolgoolga and the Churchwardens of St. Augustine's Church Woolgoolga, praying that we would by virtue of our Episcopal Authority grant a Faculty for the erection of a new Church (described below) to be dedicated to St. Augustine

A BRICK CHURCH WITH TILED ROOF in length 26.620 metres in width 12.540 metres with side chapel in length 8.120 metres in width 4.520 metres, a vestry 5.060 metres by 4.250 metres and attached flower room 2.790 metres by 4.250 metres together with portico and provision for a gallery at the west end in length 6.260 metres and in width 12.540 metres; the sanctuary and vestry floor of concrete and the nave floor of timber. To be erected on Lot A FP 327614 Scarborough Street, Woolgoolga N.S.W.

NOW THEREFORE, WE, DONALD NORMAN by Divine Providence BISHOP OF GRAFTON do grant this our Faculty and give consent to the abovementioned proposal.
