

BANGALOW CEMETERY PROPERTY ORDINANCE 2022
Ordinance No. 19 of 2022

An Ordinance to provide for the disposal of church land in Bangalow Cemetery in the Parish of Byron, Diocese of Grafton.

PREAMBLE

Whereas the property described in the Schedule hereto is vested in The Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton; and

Whereas it is part of Bangalow public cemetery;

Therefore it is considered appropriate that this property be transferred to local government ownership; and

Therefore, the Bishop-in-Council in pursuance of powers provided in clause 48.2 of the Diocesan Governance Ordinance 2008 hereby decrees and enacts as follows:

OPINION

1. It has become and is expedient, by reason of circumstances subsequent to the creation of any trusts relating to the property described in the schedule hereto, to dispose of the same.

POWERS TO DISPOSE

2. The Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton in whom the said property is vested are hereby empowered and directed to gift the same to the Byron Shire Council with such terms and conditions as may be determined by The Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton. Each party are to meet their own legal costs relating to the transfer.
3. The Corporate Trustees of the Diocese of Grafton are hereby authorised to execute and do all necessary deeds conveyances transfers assurances and other instruments acts and things for giving full and complete effect to the provisions of this Ordinance.

SHORT TITLE


This Ordinance may be cited as the Bangalow Cemetery Property Ordinance 2022.

SCHEDULE

All that piece or parcel of land and improvements at 1 Granuaille Crescent, Bangalow having the Property Identification Lot 2 DP 929377 in the Parish of Byron in the County of Rous in the Local Government Area of Byron.
