A LETTER FROM THE BISHOP

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

In their Bush telegraph newsletter last year the Little Brothers of Francis reminded us that in St Francis' Rule for Brothers living in a Hermitage there is a reference to Matthew's Gospel: their first care should be to strive first for the kingdom of God and his righteousness.

Central to the prayer life of Christians is the prayer our Saviour gave us, the Lord's Prayer or the Our Father. A line asks that God's kingdom will come, that God's will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. We all live in a particular context. Some in relative freedom such as in Australia, others in situations of conflict or injustice. Many today are displaced from their homelands and living in a foreign land. But no matter what earthly empire or circumstance we might live in, our prayer is the same – that the way of God's kingdom might be our way now, as we wait in hope for its final fulfilment.

As we pray we are united with other Christians who likewise use this prayer our Saviour gave us. For all of us, our first care should be to strive first for the kingdom of God and his righteousness
